







Winter is a time when there is an increase in people posing as utility workers to gain access to your personal information. We care about you and your loved ones and take customer safety very seriously.

To arm yourself against people falsely claiming to be utility workers, follow these important tips:

**Ask for PGW branded ID** – All PGW employees carry photo ID. If someone at your door does not have it, or refuses to produce ID, don't let them into your home. Call 911 immediately.

## Don't give out personal information -

PGW employees who come to your home will never ask for your credit card, social security or account numbers or request any other personally identifiable information.

**Call 911** – If you have any uncertainty, call 911. The Philadelphia Police Department has a direct line to PGW and can verify a utility worker's identity.

Pay inside – When visiting a PGW Customer Service Center, go inside to handle account payments, make payment arrangements or sign up for a program. Our employees never conduct business outside of our offices.

## STAY WARM, SAVE MONEY THIS WINTER

We know every penny counts these days.

Here are some tips that can lower your monthly bill and improve your home's energy efficiency:

- Set your thermostat as low as is comfortable for your family while you're awake.
- Cover drafty windows with heavy-duty, clear plastic or tape plastic film inside your window frames.
- Install tight-fitting, insulating drapes or shades on windows.
- Turn down your thermostat
  7 to 10 degrees when you're asleep or away from home.
- Add caulk or weatherstripping to seal air leaks around doors and windows.
- Seal air leaks around utility cut-throughs for pipes, around chimneys, and unfinished spaces behind cabinets and closets.
