Apply early!

LIHEAP

Simple. Quick. Worth it.

Get a head start on your cold weather gas bills. You know that a LIHEAP grant means extra money to help pay your PGW heating bill. If you received LIHEAP last year, your personal application form is on its way!

To make sure you don't miss out on grants up to \$1,000:

- Check 'natural gas' in **Section 4**
- Write 'Philadelphia Gas Works' and your PGW account number in **Section 6**
- Send 30-days proof of income with your application

If you don't receive an early application, apply for LIHEAP beginning Wednesday, November 1.

PREPARE NOW TO SAVE MONEY ON WINTER HEATING BILLS



There are steps you can take today that will pay off when the chill of fall and winter arrives. Weatherizing your home can help lower your monthly bill, and keep your family cozy when the temperatures drop.

HERE ARE SOME SIMPLE, ENERGY SAVING TIPS:

- Clean or replace your heating system's air filter.
- Make sure your air vents are not blocked.
- Keep doors and air vents closed in rooms that are not being used.
- Use caulking and weather stripping around doors and windows to reduce air flow.
- Replace old doors with insulated metal or fiberglass doors to reduce air flow.
- Have your gas furnace cleaned and serviced by a professional for greater efficiency.
- Replace old appliances with energy-efficient models carrying the ENERGY STAR label.
- Add a layer of insulation around ventilator ducts and water pipes that pass through unheated areas of your home.
- Cover bare floors with carpeting or rugs. The layers add comfort and retain heat.
- Direct your vents' airflow across the floor because warm air rises.

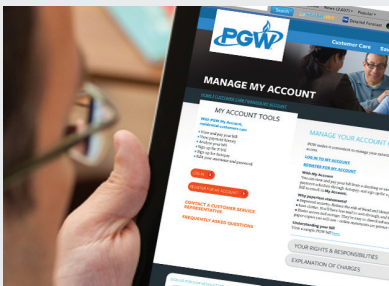

THINK YOU SMELL GAS?

Natural gas has an unpleasant, rotten egg-like odor for easy detection and your safety. If you think you smell gas, leave the area immediately, then call PGW at **215-235-1212**.

Remember, if you think you smell gas:

- NEVER** Use electrical devices.
- NEVER** Use an open flame, matches or lighter.
- NEVER** Try to locate the source of the gas leak.
- NEVER** Try to shut off any natural gas valves or appliances.
- NEVER** Flip the light switch on or off.
- NEVER** Re-enter the building or return to the area until a qualified utility representative says it is safe to do so.
